<p>For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.</p> <p><i>Malachi 3:6</i></p>	<p>Whoso keepeth the commandment shall feel no evil thing: and a wise man's heart discerneth both time and judgment.</p> <p><i>Ecclesiastes 8:5</i></p>
<p>Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.</p> <p><i>Galatians 6:7-9</i></p>	<p>And this I pray, ① that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment; ② that ye may approve things that are excellent; ③ that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ; ④ being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.</p> <p><i>Philippians 1:9-11</i></p>
<p>See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is.</p> <p><i>Ephesians 5:15-17</i></p>	<p>And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; ① speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; ② giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; ③ submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.</p> <p><i>Ephesians 5:18-21</i></p>
